"My goal with each of the Belle Glos single-vineyard Pinot Noirs is to express the genuine uniqueness of each vineyard site and to craft the most honest style of California Pinot Noir, which is layered, complex, fruit-forward and rich."

As a fifth generation Napa Valley winemaker, Joe learned his way around a vineyard long before he was able to drink wine. By the time he was 19 he knew that he would continue his family's winemaking legacy, working alongside his father at Caymus Vineyards. In 2001, he

created Belle Glos, with a focus on vineyard-designated Pinot Noirs from throughout California's best coastal regions.

More recently, he has launched a number of new brands under Copper Cane Wines & Provisions. Joe has a keen interest in contributing to the evolution of the wine industry, by discovering new wine growing locations and through experimentation in the cellar.

Joe lives in Napa Valley, has six children, and maintains a healthy balance between his family life and a passionate dedication to his business.



Owner/winemaker, Joe Wagner chose the name Belle Glos (pronounced "bell gloss") to honor his grandmother, Lorna Belle Glos Wagner. Lorna was a co-founder of Caymus Vineyards, an inspirational figure to Joe and an avid lover of Pinot Noir.







#### DAIRYMAN PINOT NOIR

#### RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY, SONOMA COUNTY **OPULENT BERRY FRUIT**

AROMAS: Black cherry and ripe plums combine with notes of dried herbs and smoke.

PALATE: Ripe red and black berry fruit flavors, great structure, smooth tannins and a lingering fresh finish.

FIRST PLANTED: 2003 ELEVATION: 81-88'



#### **EULENLOCH PINOT NOIR**

## NAPA VALLEY **BOLD & VELVETY**

AROMAS: Boysenberry, blackberry, cherry, and a hint of cocoa. PALATE: Well structured with marionberry, hints of brown sugar and chocolate nibs. This wine is velvety with supple, refined tannins and a silky, lush finish.

FIRST PLANTED: TBD ELEVATION: 7-80'



#### LAS ALTURAS PINOT NOIR

#### SANTA LUCIA HIGHLANDS, MONTEREY COUNTY **RICH & ROBUST**

AROMAS: Sun-warmed blackberries, ripe plums with hints of black licorice. PALATE: Dark berry fruit and dark chocolate with undertones of vanilla and cedar oak. Refined tannins, firm acidity and explosive layers of ripe fruit.

FIRST PLANTED: 1999 ELEVATION: 550-1120'

## SANTA MARIA VALLEY, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY FRESH & SPICY

AROMAS: Blackberry bramble, nutmeg and a hint of caramel. PALATE: Perfectly balanced with refreshing acidity, velvety tannins and

a hint of toffee carrying through the long finish. FIRST PLANTED: 1973 ELEVATION: 591-694'
